## **Before You Go**

LIGHTING	<ul> <li>Set up motion-activated or timer-controlled lights to deter nighttime trespassers.</li> <li>Keep pathways, entries, and outdoor areas well-lit to discourage intruders.</li> </ul>
LANDSCAPING	<ul> <li>Trim overgrown trees and bushes, especially around windows and doors, to eliminate hiding spots.</li> <li>Use strategic landscaping—such as thorny shrubs or gravel beds—to add natural barriers around your property.</li> </ul>
SHEDS, GARAGES, & EQUIPMENT	<ul> <li>Lock up sheds, garages, and gates—these are common weak points in home security.</li> <li>Secure or store away valuables like bikes, tools, and grills.</li> </ul>
DOORSTEP & ENTRY SECURITY	<ul> <li>Monitor deliveries and visitors to your home; consider a video doorbell.</li> <li>Avoid hidden spare keys; opt for keypads and smart locks for keyless security.</li> <li>Position any security cameras to monitor driveways, side yards, and entrances.</li> </ul>

DOORS & WINDOWS	Use deadbolts and window locks—even on upper levels. Update your alarm system codes. Consider window contact sensors or glass-break detectors—especially on the basement and ground levels—to alarm when opened. Consider shatter-resistant window film to deter forced entry.
SUPPLIES & PREPAREDNESS	Keep drinking water on hand, and stay hydrated, even when you're not thirsty. Stock a basic or travel first aid kit. Store important documents and valuables in a fireproof, waterproof safe.
VEHICLES	Service your car before road trips: check tires, brakes, oil, and fluids. Pack or inspect your emergency roadside kit, including a spare tire. Remove or conceal valuables, whether you're taking your car or leaving it behind.
OCCUPIED APPEARANCE	Use smart plugs or timers for indoor lights to mimic daily routines. Keep a car in the driveway (even if it's not your own), or arrange for lawn care. Ask a trusted neighbor to collect your mail and keep an eye on your property.
ONLINE SHARING	Don't advertise your absense—save the vacation posts for when you return.
